Dear Hudsonview Family,

Our facility has continuously followed all CDC guidelines and NJDOH recommendations since the pandemic started. We have adjusted to the constant changes to keep our residents safe.

This is a brief update about COVID-19 cases and the facility's precautions as of November 30th. We need to remain vigilant as more and more cases of COVID-19 are occurring in our community. As of November, 2 new residents and 1 staff member tested positive. As a response to this situation, the staff will be tested every other day for the next two weeks.

Anyone entering the facility will be required to take a rapid test, except for 911 personnel for emergencies. We will continue caregiver visits with a significant decrease in appointments per day.

As a safer way to avoid contracting the virus, we recommend scheduling a window visit by contacting care@hudsonviewrehab.com or a video call at call@hudsonviewrehab.com to make it safer for you, the community, and particularly, our residents.

What do you like most about your job?


I love walking into work, feeling that we are all a big family!
